We look forward to welcoming all learners back on site on the Monday, the school will return to all previous arrangements for entering and dismissing the children. Foundation Phase only a minor change, older siblings will be dismissed with their younger siblings:

Reception - 3.00pm, Year 1 - 3:05pm and Year 2 - 3:10pm, Year 3, 3:15pm, Year 4 soon after, with Year 5 and 6 those who walk 3:20pm.

The school gates will be open from 8:30am and we would like all children in class and ready to learn by 8:55am, this allows for a prompt start to morning lessons. We really want to make the most of the lesson with all children.
