Dear parents and carers,

It would appear that we managed the recent Strep A/ Scarlet fever/chicken pox and I have not had to contact Public Health Wales with any more cases. Please remain vigilant and follow all the latest advice should it be needed.

## **Teacher Strike Action.**

We face the impending strike action from teachers in the NEU. I was promised LA correspondence today but as yet I have not received information. I will do my best to explain the situation. We have teachers and support staff in a variety of unions, including the NEU. As you will have seen in the news, the NEU have opted to take part in strike action.

The following information is taken from the NEU website;

### ***When are the strike days?***

*The NEU is declaring seven days of strike action in February and March, though any individual school/ member will only be affected by four of them.*

*The union is calling teachers in state-funded schools in England, teachers in sixth form colleges, and teachers and support staff in state-funded schools in Wales to take action on the following dates:*

***Wednesday 1 February 2023: all eligible members in England and Wales.***

***Tuesday 14 February 2023: all eligible members in Wales.***

***Wednesday 15 March 2023: all eligible members in England and Wales.***

***Thursday 16 March 2023: all eligible members in England and Wales.***

### ***What does it mean when you go on strike?***

*Strike action means you do not go into work on the day the action is taking place, nor work online. You do not have to phone your school on the day to tell them you are not coming in.*

I will be able to inform those classes affected as soon as action has been confirmed. We fully appreciate this will cause families some disruption. The following link should take you to a NEU document explaining the situation.
