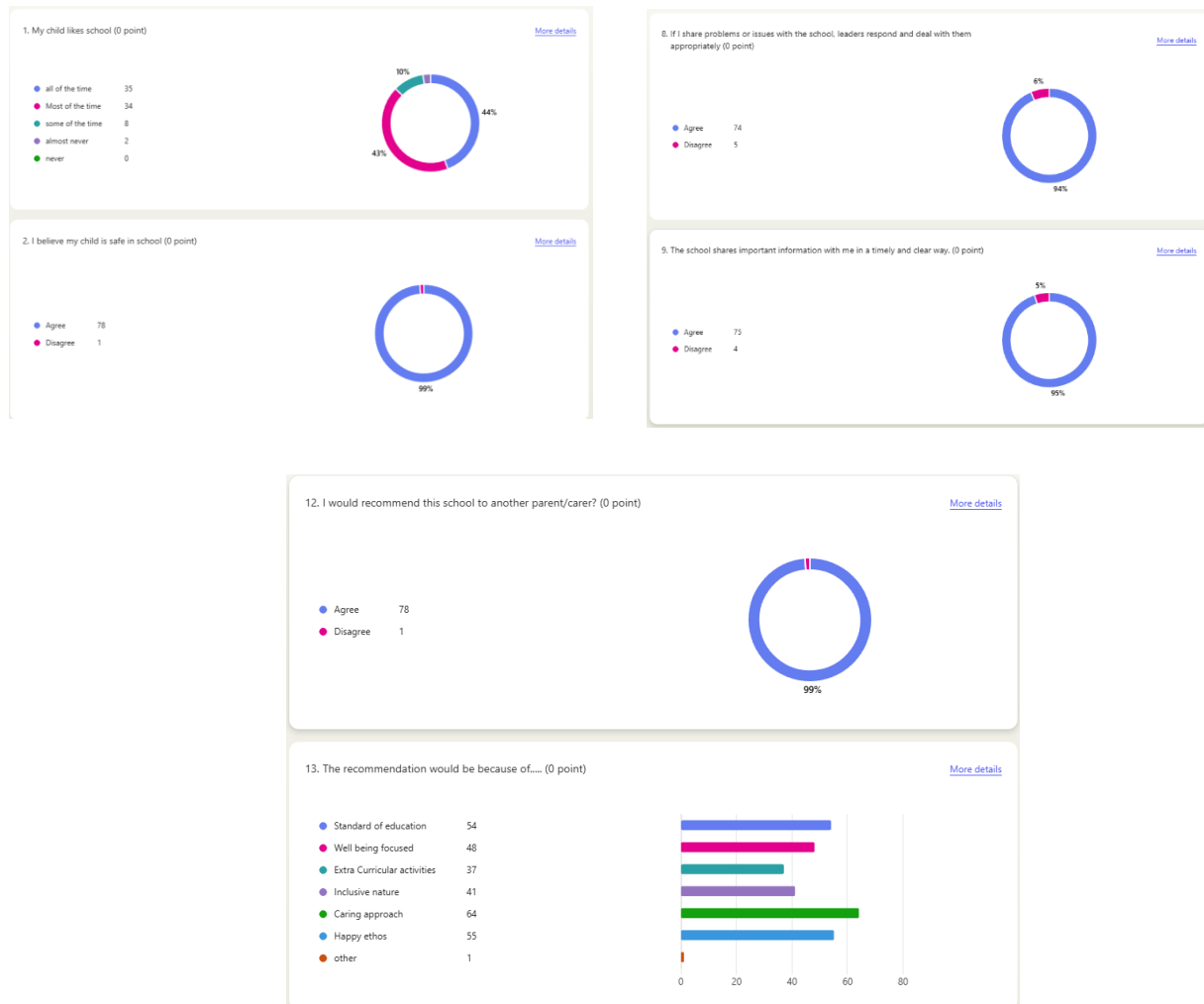
- **High Levels of Satisfaction:** The majority of parents agree that their children enjoy school and feel safe.

We also received feedback on:

- Dojo and its limits - *Sometimes to dojo doesn't give us access to information easily that's historic and I have entered 'Disagree' to the sharing information question as the Class Dojo does not have the functionality to search for previous posts.*

Thank you for sharing your views regarding the accessibility of information on Class Dojo and the school website. We understand how important it is for parents to have easy access to key information.

We are pleased to inform you that this is something we can address. We will be adding a dedicated dates section to our website, making it easier for you to access important information, such as inset days, whenever you need it.

- School meals have significantly decreased in quality and quantity since the provision of free meals.

Please note that the school meals are organized separately from the school, but we will certainly share your feedback with the catering department.

- Vehicles accessing the school grounds when the children are entering/exiting school is still an issue.

We are actively working to address this issue and will be reinforcing our policies to ensure that vehicles do not enter the school grounds during these critical times.

- Volunteering opportunities for assistance with trips or activities within the classroom are seldom offered/communicated to the wider group of parents, with the same small group of volunteers being approached.

We understand that it may seem like the same small group of volunteers is always approached.

First and foremost, all volunteers must complete all safeguarding checks to ensure the safety and well-being of our pupils. This may appear as a small group, but they are a dedicated group who have completed our volunteer pack and are fully vetted.

We appreciate your interest in volunteering and will work to better communicate these opportunities to the wider group of parents.
